	8.1	<p>HCC Roy Perry's Report. Cllr Perry was unable to attend the Meeting but had sent a report which the Chairman read.</p> <p>Finance. Despite the increase in Council Tax, Hampshire's is the lowest of any County precept in England & Wales.</p> <p>Education. A Government White Paper shows the intention of making every school (including Primary) an Academy. Smaller primary schools (especially rural) could be put at risk.</p> <p>Highways & Environment. The A3057 road bridge across the M27 will require replacement in the near future. A proposed 26tonne weight limit may be put in place. Consultation on HWRCs continues but Bunny Lane is secure for now.</p> <p>Mobile Library. Consultation continues but if mobile libraries are stopped the home book service will continue. Romsey library is secure.</p> <p>Devolution. The Solent City proposal with an elected Mayor is still under consideration. Not every area of Hampshire is happy with this (including TVBC). HCC agreement would be necessary for any part of Hampshire to be included.</p>	
	8.2	<p>Test Valley Borough Councillors report. Following the Appeal decision to refuse two of the Adanac Park developments, Barker-Mill are now planning to appeal against the Test Valley Local Plan.</p> <p>NA reported on a proposal to place two gas powered electric generators at the Crescent Estates site along Station Road, Nursling. There were serious concerns at this proposal, especially as a similar Application had been refused.</p>
