2.	24/00467/TPOS Morinda, the Green, Rownhams - Erection of 2 storey side extensions, single storey orangery, and single storey extension to garage to provide annexe.
3.	24/00741/FULLS Rownhams Services M27 West Bound Services – Construction of sub-station to facilitate 6 EV chargers.
4.	24/00772/FULLS 44 Testlands Ave, Nursling - Single storey rear extension, raise roof with loft conversion and dormers, gable end to sides, and replacement of slate roof (retrospective).
