Up to 3 metres to be removed and reduce remaining lateral growth up to 1 metre to shape canopy. No Objection
2.	26/00328/TPOS, HAMILTON, 12 BAKERS DROVE, ROWNHAMS – 1-3 English Oak. Reduce in height and spread by 4-5 metres, remove lowest west aspect limb from tree. No Objection
3.	26/00328/TPOS, 31 BETTERIDGE DRIVE, ROWNHAMS – G1 Limes – Fell 3X Limes to ground level. No Objection
